APPENDIX XIII: OUT-OF-PRINT MATERIALS

- 1.1 Library patrons are eligible to use **Out-of-Print Materials** (OOPM) services provided by the National Digital Library and operated by the National Library of the Czech Republic. This service offers access to a display of full-text copies of print documents published on the territory of the Czech Republic that are no longer available on the market (including any other—also modified—editions) and that copyright law still protects. This service is provided on the basis of a license agreement between the National Library of the Czech Republic, DILIA (the Czech agency for collective management of copyright), and OOA-S, a copyright protection organization, plus an agreement about provision of this service between the National Library of Technology and the National Library of the Czech Republic.
- 1.2 This service is accessible online upon signing to your NTK patron account and observing the following conditions of use:
 - The user of the service can only read displayed documents; use their content exclusively for their personal needs; and for study, teaching, or research purposes.
 - Copying of displayed documents, i.e., their printing, downloading on USB or any other different memory device, or copying them in any other way (e.g., through a mobile phone or photo camera) is not allowed.
 - Use of any form of robots or other tools and gadgets for automatic content downloading is forbidden.
- 1.3 Violation of these conditions of use will be perceived as a violation of copyright law and will used as a reason for suspending provision of this service and may be the basis for legal sanctioning for copyright infringement. In such cases, NTK is obliged to provide, upon request from DILIA and the National Library of the Czech Republic, co-operation in ascertaining the identity of the patron who violated these conditions.
- 1.3.1 The National Library of the Czech Republic collects, processes, and stores personal data from users of this service for a period of 1 year from the use of this service, including identification data, caches, login history, and logs.
